FOUNDATIONS OF CHRISTIANITY (St. Anthony Messenger)

Rev. Michael Himes - approximately 25 min.each (duplicated with permission – 2013)

- #1 MYSTERY: Himes draws on poetry to show the only way we can speak of the deepest things is in metaphors. This is true of the deepest Mystery which is God. We are caught between saying nothing and having to say something. Rev. Himes shows us how to say that something while always being led deeper into that Mystery that is God.
- #2 CONVERSION: St. Paul may have been converted in an instant, but for most of us conversion is a life-long process. Rev. Himes describes this dynamic. It occurs through the nurturing of others, and through imitating others and ultimately imitating Christ.
- #3 FAITH: Rev. Himes shows how people often fall into “idolatry” or “relativism.” In “idolatry” people make their approach to God the only approach to god. This leads to worshiping the church instead of worshiping God. In “relativism” all forms of belief are equal. It does not really matter...it just your opinion. Drawing on the thought of great theologians Himes shows that faith is best described as “radical Monotheism.” He shows us that faith is trusting in God who possesses us, as opposed to a God we possess.
- #4 HOPE: Rev. Himes distinguishes between optimism and hope. He does this by calling sin “sin” and not a “mistake” or “psychological flaw”. He sees hope as “Christian realism” which is a middle way between utopianism and despair. In conclusion we are moved to embrace a broken world loved by God ...as Jesus did.
- #5 LOVE: Love is not a feeling or an emotion. Love does not “happen” to you. Love is a choice...a choice for the good of the other. It demands wisdom and courage. The description of “agape” as “self-gift” is sure to inspire and challenge every viewer.

Three days are the center and climax of our Christian Year.
- (1) HOLY THURSDAY
After the powerful scripture readings, the video shows how three different parishes wash each other's feet, raise a collection for the poor, celebrate Eucharist and, process with the Blessed Sacrament.
- (2) GOOD FRIDAY

From Thursday night until sundown on Saturday, the church prays and keeps the paschal fast. At the vigil, the cantor proclaims the Exsultet—"This is the Night." From a blazing fire, candles are lit; stories of our salvation are proclaimed. Finally, the catechumens process to the font.
They renounce evil, profess their faith in Jesus, are baptized and anointed with Chrism and joyfully rejoin the assembly to participate in the Eucharist.
