#### **MINUTES**

#### **ACKNOWLEDGMENT**

Bishop Coerver welcomed everyone to the DPC meeting and wanted to take a minute to acknowledge the challenging work of our out-going members and to welcome our new members. Each member introduced themselves to the council. The Bishop gave a brief overview to the new members and explained the purpose of the DPC Council was to be a Consultative Body to the Bishop. He does not make any decisions without his Consultative Boards. Unfortunately, one of his biggest concerns was that most decisions have already been made with other Consultative bodies, and he is usually just reporting to the DPC of those decisions. This group was extremely helpful to him in making decisions during Covid and he was very appreciative of all their input and support during this challenging time. Some of the outgoing members gave a brief outline of what they experienced while serving the council and dealing with Covid and other issues that affected the Diocese. The Bishop

thanked the retiring council members for their experience and leadership and welcomed all the new members.

The Deans are another Consultative Body that the Bishop relies on. If you hear of a grievance or complaint, he encouraged the DPC to take it up with the Dean in their Deanery and then, they bring it to the Bishop for discussion and direction.

He also spoke of the importance of keeping sensitive and confidential issues that happen in the Diocese to this Council only. Sometimes, issues come up that are confidential in nature, and they should not be discussed with others in the parishes. He asked that the DPC members keep Confidential Information to themselves. We do need to respect people's privacy and reputation.
