DIOCESE OF LUBBOCK YOUTH CODE OF CONDUCT

Youth should understand that any action inconsistent with or failure to act mandated by this Code of Conduct may result in removal from the event. The following guidelines have been established to help youth participate, understand their roles, and model appropriate behaviors:

- 1. Each person is to be assigned a chaperone. Check in with your chaperone regularly and keep them informed of your location at all times.
- 2. Respect for all adult leaders, peers, and all property is expected.
- 3. Youth will model an image of Christian consideration, sensitivity, and respect to everyone in language, dress, and behavior.
- 4. Adhere to the stated curfew.
- 5. Any/all medications (OTC/RX) shall be documented on Medical Release Form
- Participants are expected to attend all scheduled activities. For your safety, you are not permitted to leave the activity site without the permission of the Youth Minister/PCL/Diocesan Director.
- 7. Youth who cause problems will be reported to the Youth Minister/PCL/Diocesan Director. Parents will be notified if necessary, and the youth will be sent home.
- 8. The Diocese of Lubbock does not tolerate actions of bullying, harassment, separation from the group, or any other form of inappropriate behavior.
- 9. Inappropriate contact, touch, gestures, language, or activity of any offensive nature is NOT PERMITTED.
- 10. NO illegal drugs, underage smoking, firearms, explosives; the purchase, possession, or consumption of alcoholic beverages or tobacco products by minors will not be tolerated.
